

Unknown Suspect Wanted for Commercial Armed Robbery Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating an unknown suspect wanted for a commercial armed robbery in the Otay Mesa West area.

On December 26, 2016, at 9:50 p.m., a male suspect, armed with a handgun, entered the Little Caesars Pizza restaurant located at 4370 Palm Avenue in San Diego. The suspect ordered all the customers to lay face down on the floor. The suspect told the employee to open the cash drawer. The employee complied and the suspect stole an undisclosed amount of cash, stuffing it into his sweatshirt pocket. The suspect left the restaurant and was last seen running through an apartment complex located in the 4200 block of Palm Avenue.

Suspect's Description:

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, 20's to early 30's, 6'0" to 6'1" tall, medium build, wearing a blue bandana with a white paisley design across his face, a gray hooded sweatshirt with "Ecko Unlimited" logo on the front, and black "Dickie" style pants.
