Unknown Suspects Wanted for Commercial Robbery Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Eastern Division are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate three unknown suspects wanted for commercial robbery in the Kearny Mesa area.

On December 15, 2015, at approximately 7:24 p.m., three unknown suspects entered the Spring Mobile store located at 8006 Clairemont Mesa Boulevard, in San Diego. The three suspects began to rip cell phones and tablets from their display stands. A store employee was in the back of the store when he heard the noise. The employee confronted one of the suspects, who told the employee to stay where he was and that nobody would get hurt. The suspects continued to rip items from the store displays. The suspects ran out of the store and no vehicle was seen. The total loss to the store was over \$ 6,500 worth of products. Investigators believe these suspects may be involved in additional similar incidents in the Kearny Mesa area.

Suspects' Descriptions: All three suspects were Black males in their late teens to early 20's in age. All three suspects had medium builds and were wearing hooded sweatshirts.
