Used Oil Recycling Event to be Held in Paradise Hills LAST USED AUTO PRODUCT RECYCLING EVENT IN 2016

SAN DIEGO – City of San Diego residents are encouraged to bring their used or leftover motor oil and oil filters, as well as fluorescent light bulbs and household batteries, for recycling at the City Environmental Services Department's <u>Used Auto Product Recycling Event</u> on Saturday, Dec. 3 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. The event will be held at the School of Creative & Performing Arts at 2425 Dusk Drive in Paradise Hills.

A few important details:

- Used motor oil, oil filters, contaminated oil and antifreeze are accepted;
- The City also accepts fluorescent light bulbs, car batteries and household batteries;
- The service is FREE to City of San Diego residents only;
- No commercial or business waste will be accepted;
- Maximum transportation limit: 10 gallons or 125 pounds.
