FIREARMS AND ILLEGAL KNIVES			May 20, 1983

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3.2.1 PURPOSE

To inform Park and Recreation Department employees of City regulations prohibiting the possession of firearms and illegal knives.

3.2.2 AUTHORITY

City Manager's Directive of July 28, 1976. Memorandum of Understanding by and between the City of San Diego and San Diego Municipal Employees' Association, Article 20. Memorandum of Understanding by and between the City of San Diego and Local 127, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Article 30.

3.2.3 POLICY

No Park and Recreation Department employee shall carry or have in a City vehicle or on City maintained property or structures any type of firearms or illegal knives during the course of City employment. Possession of a permit to carry a firearm does not exempt an employee from the requirements of this Policy.

A. Definition

Firearms and knives shall include those listed in the above referenced sections of the Memorandums of Understanding and the appropriate California Penal Code sections. For the purpose of this Policy, tools required or normally used on the job are not to be considered weapons.

B. Compliance

Violation of this Policy shall be cause for serious disciplinary action including termination.
