Good morning. A few quick updates to share:

I am proud to announce **Rancho Bernardo Road** from West Bernardo to the City limit and **Bernardo Center Drive** from Bernardo Heights Parkway to West Bernardo are officially set to be repaved. Work has already begun on Rancho Bernardo Road and should be complete in less than a month (weather permitting). In Rancho Penasquitos, replacement of **Carmel Mountain Road** from Black Mountain Road to Entreen Road will be moving forward this fiscal year, in addition to the stretch of Carmel Mountain Road that was recently completed. In Scripps Ranch, we will be redoing **Scripps Ranch Boulevard** from Affinity Court to Spring Canyon Road. I anticipate having good news to share soon on plans to repave **Camino Del Norte**. The communities of District Five have awaited these improvements for a long time and are finally seeing the investment they deserve.

I also wanted to let you know that **the date and location of my first Signature Event has changed**. It will now be held on April 24 at Carmel Mt. Ranch Library. See below for more details.
