GENTLEMEN:

Attached hereto is Municipal License No. 09316 issued to Mrs. Josefa Esquerria DBA P. I. Cafe at 630 Market Street, San Diego, as a Class A Dine and Dance establishment. This license has been suspended for a period of five days by the Chief of Police, pursuant to Section 13 of Ordinance No. 581 (N.S.). Section 13 reads as follows:

"The Chief of Police of The City of San Diego is hereby authorized temporarily to suspend any license issued under the provisions of this ordinance in the event that any public dance hall or public dance licensed thereby is being conducted in violation of any law or ordinance. Such temporary suspension shall expire at the end of five days unless the Chief of Police shall have filed written charges with the Council of The City of San Diego. Upon investigation of any such charges the City Council shall have power, by resolution, to revoke the suspension order theretofore made by the Chief of Police, to suspend the license for such further period as it may deem proper, or to revoke and annul such license."

For any violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance, or for any cause by it deemed sufficient, the Council of The City of San Diego may at any time, by resolution suspend or revoke any license issued under the terms of this ordinance."

It is respectfully recommended that your Honorable Body revoke and annul the Class A Dance license of Mrs. Esquerria, pursuant to the authority contained in the section above quoted.

Attached hereto is the recommendation of the Chief of Police respecting such revocation, as well as Police Department report covering current violation of Ordinance No. 581 (N.S.) leading to the suspension of the license and the recommendation to your Honorable Body for its revocation.
