I wanted to share the following construction advisory from the City's Public Works Department regarding the closure of the intersection at Ted Williams Parkway and Shoal Creek Drive related to the construction of the new Shoal Creek pedestrian bridge.

The intersection of Ted Williams Parkway and Shoal Creek Drive will be closed the nights of April 7th, 8th and 9th from 10 PM to 5 AM. Access through the intersection during these hours will be limited and you may experience delays.

During tonight's closure, cranes will be performing work that will require access through the intersection to be halted to all vehicles and pedestrians.

I ask that you please plan accordingly and avoid the area if possible.
