I wanted to share the following construction advisory from the City's Public Works Department regarding the night work occurring at Ted Williams Parkway and Shoal Creek Drive related to the construction of the new Shoal Creek pedestrian bridge.

**Construction crews will be performing night work on the Ted Williams Parkway Pedestrian Bridge project located at Ted Williams Parkway and Shoal Creek Drive starting on Sunday night, June 29<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday morning, July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2014 between, approximately, 10 PM to 5 AM.**

**On the night of June 29<sup>th</sup>, the crews will begin painting the Ted Williams Parkway Pedestrian Bridge, through Wednesday morning, July 16<sup>th</sup>. The night work will occur Sunday through Thursday nights (the night work excludes Friday and Saturday nights). Accommodations for ingress and egress off of Shoal Creek Drive will be provided.**
