## Charter Review Committee to Hold Evening Meeting That Will Include an "Open Public Forum"

SAN DIEGO --- San Diego City Council President Sherri Lightner announced that the June 11, 2015 Charter Review Committee will meet tomorrow at 6:00 p.m. in the evening to accommodate residents who are unavailable during daytime hours and cannot attend the regularly scheduled 2:00 p.m. meetings. The final item on the agenda is a "Public Hearing on Charter issues not on the agenda", where residents can address the committee directly, and provide their suggestions for revising the City's Charter.

"It is important to hold evening meetings to provide opportunities to hear from everyone who has ideas regarding improving and revising our City Charter," said Council President Lightner. "The Charter is the Constitution for the City, and it's important that citizens have a voice in determining our governing documents."
