City Gate Study/Fire Stations: Marty Emerald, Ken Barnes, Mark Nassar, Chris Olsen, Alan Arrollado - City Gate report identifying gaps in Fire coverage and proposing a \$205M Bond Measure to raise funds for 19 new Fire Stations to fill the gaps. Creating design templates to shorten process and fast track programs to build. The \$41.8M/Yr. cost to fund stations operations will be budgeted gradually over time. Engines and equipment are included in the annual cost. R. Hixson commented that the proposed Ocean View station should be added to the list of priority stations. M. Emerald agreed to add to the list and it was acknowledged that if the Bond Measure succeeds, the Britannia Station on the priority list would then be removed from the FBA funding schedule.
