- 1. **Call to Order/Introduction of Members:** The meeting was called to order at 6:33 p.m. by Vice Chair Jacki Farrington, at the Otay Mesa Nestor Branch Library. She welcomed all Board members and members of the community to the meeting of the Otay Mesa-Nestor Community Planning Group (OMNCPG).
- **2. Approval of minutes** A Motion was made by Bob Mikloski to approve the minutes of the September, 2015, OMNCPG Meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
- 3. Non-Agenda Public Comments:
 - a. The second Palm Avenue Revitalization Workshop will be held from 6 to 8 pm, November 4, 2015, at the American Legion Imperial Beach Post 820, 1268 Palm Avenue, San Diego, CA 92154.

 - a. Officer Lacarra gave the following report:
 - 1. He said that there was an officer involved shooting in the 1100 block of San Ysidro Blvd.
 - 2. He also reported that store ATMs were stolen out of two stores in the area.
 - 3. There was a graffiti arrest in the 1400 block of Paseo Aurora, 2 adults and 1 juvenile were arrested for graffiti, and may face additional charges.
 - 4. There were recent promotions: Officer Korbecki made Detective, and the Southern Division gained an additional supervisor.

- 5. **Council District 8 Report:** District 8 Representative Gerrlyn Gacao, Council Representative, 619-236-6688 ggacao@sandiego.gov:
 - a. She said that the SANDAG board has voted to push out new transportation projects in District 8 in South Bay for several decades into the future.
 - b. She also said that needed improvements to the Otay Mesa Nestor Community Library building are still under study.
 - c. The undergrounding project locations for Egger Heights will be announced at a public meeting to be held November 4th.
 - d. City of San Diego staff has recently held meetings to plan for storm water preparedness.
 - 1. There are several storm drain channels in South Bay that have been known to flood.
 - 2. Permits to clean out these channels take several years to obtain.
 - 3. Call the City of San Diego Storm Water hotline at 619-527-7500.
 - e. Free legal clinics will be held on November 17, 18, and 19, from 1 to 4 pm at the Otay Mesa Nestor Community Library.
 - f. A contract to install new sidewalks on Otay Mesa Road by the high school will soon be awarded.
 - g. Councilmember Alvarez will hold office hours at the Otay Mesa Nestor Community Library from 10 am to 12 pm on November 12th.
 - h. A new library in San Ysidro is now moving forward, there will be a town hall meeting about the project on October 15th at 6 pm at the San Ysidro Middle School.

- **9. Informational Item:** Sarah Mitchell and Dennis Schroeder of Shea Homes reported about the infill project soon to begin at the former Marian High School site:
 - a. They said that 170 single family detached homes, each with a two car garage, will be built on this site by Shea Homes.
 - 1. 91 homes will be built between about 1,600 and 1,900 square feet in size.
 - 2. 84 homes will be constructed between about 2,100 and 2,400 square feet in size.
 - b. They hope to begin grading the site in January, 2016.
 - c. They will begin construction of the model homes in Spring, 2016.
 - d. The site will include an additional off street parking lot, open space play areas and a drainage basin.
 - e. A home owners association will be formed to oversee this new neighborhood.
 - f. They will work with Caltrans to improve the south bound off ramp at Coronado Avenue and Interstate 5.
 - g. They have paid in lieu fees to the City of San Diego affordable housing fund, however, none of this development they are building contains affordable housing.
