# **MRNPC Chair's Report for March 2016**

On the agenda this month we have:

#### (#1) Speed limit increase on Scripps Poway Parkway – (Action item)

A letter from the City Traffic Engineering was received regarding the posted speed limit on Scripps Poway Parkway (SPP) between Spring Canyon Road and Poway/SD City Limit for both eastbound and westbound traffic. A recent roadway survey indicated that the existing speed of 45 mph must be raised to 50 mph in order to remain radar enforceable. (The speed limit on SPP from I-15 to Spring Canyon Road is posted for 50 mph. The speed limit from Poway/SD City Limit up to Community Road is 55mph) The speed limit increase for SPP will be placed on the March 2016 agenda for review and recommendation.

#### (#2) Left Turn signal request at Angelique Street & Scripps Poway Parkway – (Information item)

MRN residents requested a safety evaluation at the intersection of Angelique/Springbook Dr and Scripps Poway Parkway, at the Feb 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting, due to difficulty making eastbound and westbound left turns onto SPP. The volume of cross traffic has increased over the years making left turns from dangerous. An evaluation request was submitted to City Traffic Engineering for review.

#### (#3) Appointment to membership: Luis Fregoso – (Action item)

There are 4 open seats for this election cycle. We have one new resident member candidate and two returning resident members on the March ballot. The open seat will be filled by appointment.

An opportunity to request corrections will be made in the meeting. Should no such requests be made, the Chair will deem the minutes adopted by unanimous consent.

The MedImpact and Watermark Projects are the land development sites, at the southeast corner of Scripps Poway Parkway/Mercy Road and I-15. No updates.

## 2. Administration News

(b) CPG Budget Reimbursements - City requested a "City Vendor" designate from each CPG to claim up to \$500 in reimbursement expenses for CPG costs. Michelle Abella-Shon is the designated city vendor.
(c) MRN new membership. Any resident who owns property or a business within the Miramar Ranch North boundaries is eligible for election to the planning group. There is membership information posted online at the MRN webpage. The committee will adjourn for the March elections at the end of the meeting, hold elections by ballot, and re-adjourn upon completion.
