- **Project Sheet T-41 San Ysidro Transit Priority Measures (TPM):** New project is estimated at \$1.5 million. Project details are provided in the latest draft.

- **Table of contents:** Page numbers have been revised to reflect the (2) additional transportation projects.
- Chapter 3 Transportation Component: Last paragraph on this section has been updated to reflect the (2) new projects.
- **Chapter 3 DIF Fee Schedule:** Paragraph and Fee Schedule Table have been updated. The new proposed residential fee in the draft IFS is \$10,206 per dwelling unit and \$192 per Average Daily Trip. There have been no changes to the Fire Component at \$59 per 1,000 SF. The residential transportation component went from \$1,295 to \$1,344, and the non-residential transportation component went from \$185 to \$192.
