- (7:00) 7. **Action Item:** The City of San Diego-Traffic Operations received a citizen request in March, 2016, to evaluate Halo Street for installation of speed bumps between Saturn Boulevard and Thermal Avenue. The speed study on this street demonstrated that a speeding issue warranted this traffic calming measure. The street segment met all of the City of San Diego screening criteria, and was approved by the City of San Diego Fire Department for installation of the proposed speed bumps. The City requires that at least 75% of the fronting properties sign a petition in favor of the proposed speed bumps, prior to presenting this item to the community planning group for a vote. A petition was circulated which demonstrated that the project had 87% community support.
