Re: Special Event Permit for the North Park Historical Society Car Show

To Whom It May Concern:

Since 2010, the North Park Historical Society (NPHS) has organized a classic car show for the community. The first two shows were held in the parking lot behind the North Park Theatre in the month of September. Beginning in 2012, NPHS held the show in the parking lot in front of the Balboa Tennis Club at Morley Field. The Balboa Tennis Club, who hosted the event, supports hosting the 2017 Car Show in the same location at Morley Field.

The car show, which is free to attend, has been a big hit for residents of North Park and surrounding neighborhoods. Several hundred people have attended each year. The number of car show entries has steadily increased from 40 in 2010 to between 50 and 60 each year since moving to Morley Field.

The proposed NPHS Car Show for 2017 will be held on Saturday, September 9, 2017. The date of September 9th will not conflict with either tennis tournaments or cross-country races, and NPHS will be submitting permit request with the City Park and Recreation Department. NPHS permit calls for using approximately 40% of the parking spaces in front of the tennis courts, technically part of Jacaranda Street, for approximately 7 hours on the day of the event.

Based upon positive community response to the previous three NPHS Car Shows, the North Park Planning Committee supports NPHS receiving a permit for their 2017 Car Show at Morley Field.
