1. **Historic Preservation Subcommittee:** The subcommittee met on February 27, 2017; subcommittee members Amie Hayes (Chair), Jay Newington, Mat Wahlstrom, and Tom Mullaney were in attendance. The subcommittee considered whether buildings located at the former Rees-Stealy Medical Clinic, at 2001 Fourth Avenue, should be historically designated. The City of San Diego's Historic Resources Board will hold a second hearing on the issue on March 23, 2017.
