- b. Marcela presented information about a community garden. She mentioned Suzie's Farm is going out of business, and asked about the community having access to that site. She said an operator first needs to be identified, and operating expenses submitted, then donors could be approached. Susie's Farm lease is up on December 1<sup>st</sup>. Because this land is in a floodplain, it cannot be sold.

  - b. The Brown Field Airport Master Plan Advisory Committee Meeting will occur on October 17 from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. at 2351 Otay Center Drive, San Diego 92154.

- c. Otay Valley Regional Park (OVRP) Concept Plan was approved by the City Council on October 9, 2017.
- d. OVRP Citizens Advisory Committee meeting will be held on October 19, 2017, at the Chula Vista Public Works Building, 1800 Maxwell Road, Chula Vista, CA.

Tijuana River Valley update On October 3, 2017, the San Diego City Council voted to join the cities of Chula Vista and Imperial Beach, and the Port of San Diego, in filing a lawsuit against federal government (International Boundary & Water Commission) over the sewage spills in Tijuana that have fouled the water and air in the South Bay area.

Informational Item: Steven Shinn, Gensler Architects, Lara Easton, Deputy Chief City Attorney and Stephen Maduli-Williams, Community Development Division Program Manager, informed the group about the (Process 5) Conditional Use Permit (CUP) and Coastal Development Permit (CDP) applications for a remodel, addition, and conversion of an existing motel into a transitional housing facility for the SMART program. The project site is located at 1788 Palm Avenue in the CC-4-2 Zone, within the Otay Mesa-Nestor Community Plan Area, Coastal Overlay Zone (Appealable Area), and Council District 8. These applications were filed on August 18, 2017.
