On May 21, 2018, the Citizens Advisory Board on Police/Community Relations (CAB) voted unanimously (9-0-0) to recommend that City Council amend Council Policy 000-12 (see enclosed red-lined document).

CAB recognizes City Council's and the Mayor's continuing intolerance of racial discrimination as outlined in Council Policy 000-12; however, considering recent local and national events, and on the 50th anniversary of this policy's adoption, CAB recommends that City Council reaffirm its commitment that no form of racial discrimination is acceptable.
