Port of San Diego; Ron Powell, Pollution issues a grant of 5.6 million to reduce pollution will give the ability to expand shore power system which will allow ships to not have to run the generators while in port, the grant will allow for purchase a BONNETT that will go on ships stacks and capture 100% of pollutants for ships that need to keep engines running in port.
