Statement on Item 51: Proposed Parking Requirement Regulatory Reform for Multifamily Residential Development in Transit Priority Areas

San Diego— We have second readings for a reason. In the last 2 weeks, I have received additional information from residents and responsible builders about the impacts of this policy change on specific communities. This proposed ordinance is a meat axe approach to an issue that requires sensitivity to the unique characteristics of each impacted neighborhood. I will be voting no on Item 51: Proposed Parking Requirement Regulatory Reform for Multifamily Residential Development in Transit Priority Areas.

Whatever the outcome of this vote, I will work with community groups to monitor impacts and to propose modifications to protect neighborhoods while moving toward the goals of reduced housing costs and reduced dependency on cars.
