**VI. Action Items 6:45 p.m.**

1. **Everett Hauser, Chris Ward's Office** — Presidio Drive/Jackson St. exploratory one-way concept. The goal of this potential project is to provide mobility safety enhancements for pedestrians, drivers and cyclist on Presidio Drive and Jackson Street. The project indicated requires a third part traffic study, which will cost \$49,500. The Old Town Planning Group made a motion to partially or fully help fund the Traffic Study and indicated that they would like to see if Uptown would help them pay for the study as Mission Hills residents benefit from using the roads as well.

**VII. Information Items 7:45 p.m.**

1. **Washington Street Bikeway Project** — The Washington Street and Bachman Place Bikeways project is one of five segments planned as part of the Uptown Bikeways, which will enhance neighborhood connectivity between Uptown, Old Town, Mission Valley, Downtown San Diego, North Park, and Balboa Park. SANDAG will provide a presentation detailing their plans.
2. **San Diego Regional Airport Authority Presentation** — The group will provide updates from the Airport Development Plan and the following staff will attend from the Authority: Brendan Reed, Director, Airport Planning and Environmental Affairs; Matt Harris, Director, Government Affairs, Ted Anasis, Manager, Airport Planning and Environmental Affairs.
3. **The City of San Diego Streetlight Sensors** — The City of San Diego invites you to learn about data being generated by our new streetlight sensors. The City is holding several community forums to discuss what the streetlights can and can't do and how your privacy will be protected. There are several forums available to attend in coming weeks.

4. **Notice of Hazardous Tree Removal** — The San Diego Unified School District has identified a hazardous tree located along Campus Avenue and south of Van Buren Avenue on the Eugene Brucker Education Center in University Heights. The tree will be removed between August 5 and August 8.
5. **Sustainable Growth Community Planners** — The purposed of the committee is to engage and empower CPG members who believe in addressing climate change, supporting good land use decisions, and implementing equitable transportation policies.

#### VIII. Letters of Support

2. **JDRF One Walk** – The organizers have requested a letter of support from Uptown Planners. The event is scheduled for Saturday, November 9. Last year, the San Diego Chapter raised over \$650,000 for type 1 diabetes research through the Walk.
3. **Race for Autism** – The Race for Autism Superhero 5K Run/ Walk raises funds for local autism initiatives. Race fundraising supports: San Diego teacher’s grants, community projects, parent groups, educational workshops, family activities, and vocational training programs for young adults. The walk is scheduled for March 28, 2020.
4. **UCSD Long Range Campus Expansion Plan** – David Mier presented at our June 4 board meeting and has requested that Uptown Planners provide a letter of support for the University.
