 - A. Logan Heights LID (South) for Stormwater Treatment and Flow Control
The City of San Diego is completing the design of this project that will install Green Infrastructure (GI) components to treat and filter stormwater by soaking up and storing water for water quality treatment and flow control to reduce pollutants to help achieve Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) requirements for Chollas Creek. Presented by Roberto Diawatan, Project Engineer, PW/E&CP Department, Right-Of-Way Design Division.
 - B. Circulate San Diego
