a bacteriologist to proceed with daily analyses with the
agreement that payment at the rate of \$100.00 per month would
be forthcoming.

Reports on findings are to be filed with this de-
partment and with the City Manager of Operation, daily.

It is hereby requested that your Honorable Body
sanction said action and appropriate said sum by emergency
ordinance, same to be credited to the Health Fund. This being
a matter of urgency and in the interests of public health and
safety, it is hoped no delay may occur.
