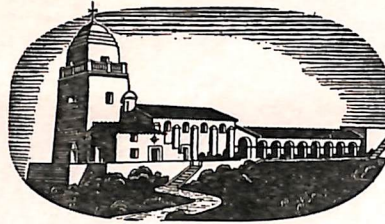

1934.

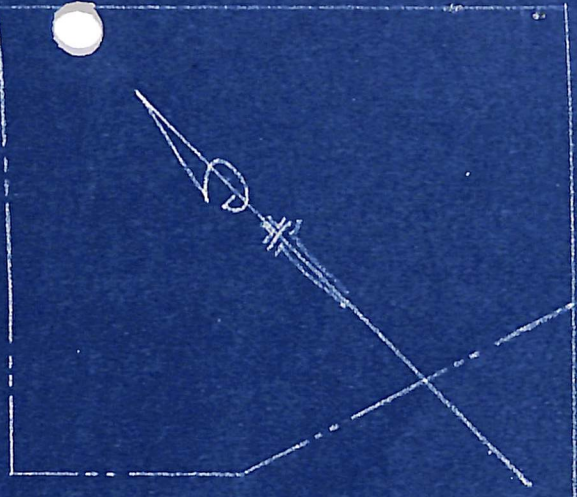

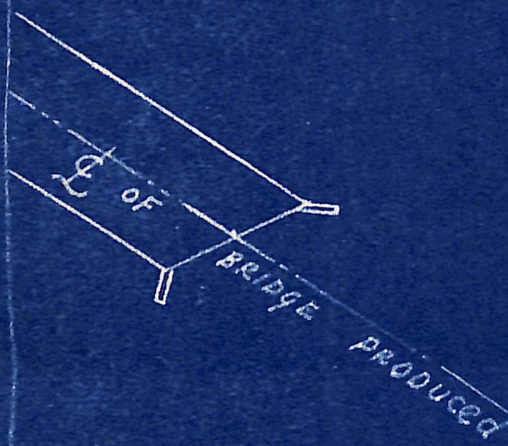
