TO THE HONORABLE, THE COUNCIL, SAN DIEGO, CALIF.


Gentlemen :

The undersigned respectfully petitions as follows :

THAT, I be granted a Class A Dine and Dance License under City Ordinance 581, at 4095 Pacific Blvd. The reason for asking this special request is that we cannot meet the requirements of Section 3 which requires at least 400 sq. ft. of dance floor. Due to the arrangement of the building it is impossible to have greater dance floor space than ~~305~~ ²⁹⁷ sq. ft. since this only allows 50 persons to be seated around the dance floor.

Not being familiar with the space requirements, the said application for license is being held up at the Inspector's office until he is notified by the City Council that a special permission is granted me and an exception is made in this case. Our opening date has been set for this coming Friday, but without dance facilities our opening on this date will be impossible, and since the investment up to now stands at \$15,000 we are anxious to open and, therefore, ask that your Honorable Body kindly give us consideration and grant us a Dine and Dance license.
