**San Diego Police Announce Arrest in June 2017 Homicide in Ocean Beach
Neighborhood**

On Thursday, June 22, 2017, at 12:28 a.m., the San Diego Police Department Communications Center received a 911 call regarding a male attacking another male on 1900 Bacon Street. The first San Diego Police Officers to arrive found a male victim lying on the west sidewalk with stab wounds to his torso.

Officers began life saving measures and the victim was transported to UCSD Hospital. Despite life saving measures, the male was pronounced deceased at the hospital. The victim was identified as 65 year old Walter “Ras” Riley of San Diego. San Diego Police Department initiated an investigation into Mr. Riley’s murder. As the result of the investigation, the lone suspect was identified as 19 year old Noah Mitchell Jackson of San Diego. A warrant was issued for Jackson’s arrest.

On Tuesday February 20, 2018 Jackson was located in Huntington Beach, California. With the assistance of the U.S. Marshals Service, the Huntington Beach Police Department, and San Diego Police Department, Jackson was taken into custody. He was transported to San Diego and booked in to County Jail for one count of murder.
