San Diego— Today, the City Council took several steps toward a final purchase and sale agreement (PSA) of the Mission Valley site. This project will grow and enhance the River Park, develop affordable housing, expand SDSU, and affirm our city's identity as an international hub for innovation.

I opposed Soccer City and was the first elected official to support Measure G.

The City of San Diego is not a real estate developer. San Diegans expect us to fulfill the promises set forth in Measure G and not add additional provisions.

The redevelopment of the Mission Valley site is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. I want to ensure that this valuable piece of land in the heart of San Diego is utilized by the entire region to the maximum benefit of all.
