Chollas Valley Community Planning Group area is located in Council District Four in the southeast part of the city of San Diego. The Board consists of 16 members from the following neighborhoods: Alta Vista, Broadway Heights, Chollas View, Emerald Hills, Encanto, Lincoln Park, O'Farrell, and Valencia Park. It is predominantly a low-density residential community with the opportunity for denser residential projects, commercial and industrial uses located near major streets and transit hubs. It has a young population with many elementary and middle schools that feed into the Lincoln High School Cluster. The area is characterized by dramatic topography of hills with significant views, and the historic Chollas Valley created by the meandering Chollas Creek. Transit is alive and present in the Chollas Valley with three San Diego Trolley/Eastern Rail Road stations at 47th Street, Euclid Avenue/Market Street and 62nd Street, as well as many bus routes, Interstate 805 and CA-94.

Community Planning Groups provide citizens with an opportunity for involvement in advising the City Council, the Planning Commission, and other decision-makers on development projects, general or community plan amendments, re-zonings and public facilities. The recommendations of the planning groups are integral components of the planning process, and are highly regarded by the City Council and by staff.
