Mayor Gloria hosted Southcrest Street Light Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony

SAN DIEGO (February 27, 2014) – Interim Mayor Todd Gloria hosted a ribbon-cutting ceremony on Thursday, February 27 at 8:30 a.m. to celebrate the installation of 49 new street lights in Southcrest at 3917 Newton Avenue. Keeping residents safe is priority in the City of San Diego. This project provides a safer neighborhood for pedestrians, residents and businesses in the area.

“This is what we strive for, to improve the quality of life for all San Diegans. One way we can do that is by making our streets safe,” said Interim Mayor Todd Gloria. “This new lighting not only does that but also turns this into one sexy street.”

Mayor Gloria was joined by District 9 Councilmember Marti Emerald, District 8 Councilmember David Alvarez, Public Works Acting Assistant Director Marnell Gibson, and representatives from Civic San Diego, along with local residents.

Installation of the streetlights will facilitate safe operation of traffic, give pedestrians a safer travelling environment, and promote night time use of sidewalks, public transportation and commercial shopping areas.
