Mayor Kevin L. Faulconer and City Council President Todd Gloria will break ground on the Juan Street Concrete Replacement Project

SAN DIEGO --- Mayor Kevin L. Faulconer and City Council President Todd Gloria will break ground on this \$8 million infrastructure project in the heart of Historic Old Town. The project is located within the Old Town San Diego Community Area and Uptown Community Area on Juan Street, which was built in 1929.

The project will provide infrastructure improvements for multi-modal accessibility (sidewalks, curb ramps and concrete street replacement), drainage (curb and gutter, cross gutters and storm drains), and water supply (water main replacement). The project footprint is along Juan Street from Taylor Street to Sunset Road.
