## City Councilmember David Alvarez will break ground on the Palm Avenue Roadway Improvements Project

SAN DIEGO --- Councilmember David Alvarez and representatives from the Public Works Department will break ground on the \$2.9 million Palm Avenue Roadway Improvements infrastructure project in Otay Mesa. The project is located on Palm Avenue east of Beyer Way to Del Cardo Avenue which will include raised medians, traffic signal improvements that will enhance vehicular safety and traffic flow, new signage and striping to increase pedestrian safety, curb ramps, bus pads with shelters, and storm drain improvements.
