City Announces Residential Tax Files Recycling Week

SAN DIEGO – With Income Tax Day fast approaching and in an effort to help San Diegans recycle old tax files, the City of San Diego Environmental Services Department and Allan Company are hosting the 14th annual Residential Tax Files Recycling Program.

When: From April 13 to April 20, 2016

Monday – Friday: 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Saturday and Sunday: 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Where: Miramar Recycling Center, 5165 Convoy St., in Kearny Mesa

Additional Details:

- This drop-off service is FREE to City of San Diego residents only;
- All documents will be securely stored and shredded before being recycled;
- Only one banker's box of residential tax files per resident is accepted. A "bankers box" is approximately 10 inches high, 15 inches wide, and 25 inches deep;
- Businesses can find recycling services under "Business Records Destruction"; and
- Remember, you can also recycle bagged, shredded paper in your blue curbside recycling bin.
