Free Sandbags Available at Local Recreation Centers

Bags in Limited Supply at Specific Rec Centers in Each Council District

SAN DIEGO – With rain in the forecast, the City of San Diego reminds City residents that free sandbags are available at specific recreation centers in each City Council District.

Sandbags are in limited supply and those presenting proof of residency can get up to 10 **empty** sandbags from centrally located recreation centers. Residents offering identification showing their home street address can pick up bags between 1 p.m. and 7 p.m. Monday through Friday and from noon to 2 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.
