'Women Working Wonders in Water' Workshop to Feature Pure Water San Diego Tours

YOUNG WOMEN TO COLLABORATE WITH LOCAL SCIENCE INSTITUTIONS

SAN DIEGO – Young female students will explore the City of San Diego's demonstration Pure Water Facility and learn how the water purification process works as part of the "Women Working Wonders in Water Workshop."

The group is part of BE WiSE, a program that engages teenage girls in grades 7-12 in science, technology, engineering and math, and teaches experiences in collaboration with the region's research, industry and academic institutions. BE WiSE stands for "Better Education for Women in Science and Engineering."

The workshop, sponsored by the City and Carolla Engineers, will take place on Saturday, Nov. 4 at the City's North City Water Reclamation Plant, 4949 Eastgate Mall, from 9 a.m. to noon.

Besides touring of the Pure Water Facility, participants will hear about careers in the water industry from female engineers and conduct hands-on water sustainability experiments.
