Torrey Pines High School Threat Arrest

San Diego—On Friday, February 23, 2018, The San Diego Police Department’s Northwestern Division Juvenile Services Team was advised of a potential school shooter threat to Torrey Pines High School. Preliminary information to law enforcement was a juvenile, who did not attend Torrey Pines High School, made a threat to conduct a shooting at the school. The San Diego Police Department began an immediate investigation into the allegations. As a result, the subject was identified as a 16 year old juvenile. The juvenile was located, a search of his residence was conducted, and no firearms were located. The subject was taken to Juvenile hall. The investigation is ongoing.
