La Jolla High School Threat Arrest

San Diego—On March 8th 2018, in the late afternoon, The San Diego Police Department's Northern Division Officers and Detectives were advised of a potential school shooter threat to La Jolla High School. Preliminary information to law enforcement was a 15 year-old male juvenile, who attends La Jolla High School, made a threat to conduct a shooting at the school. The San Diego Police Department began an immediate investigation into the allegations.

As a result, the investigation revealed the crime of 422 PC (Criminal Threats) was committed by the juvenile. On March 9th 2018, the juvenile was located, a search of his residence was conducted and no firearms were located. The juvenile was detained and placed into Juvenile Hall. The investigation is currently ongoing.
