Arrest Made in Felony Vandalism to Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Logan Heights

San Diego CA. – On April 2, 2018, at approximately 1 p.m., an unknown female walked onto the grounds of Our Lady of Guadalupe Church located at 1770 Kearny Avenue. The female threw a wooden kneeler at a Plexiglas window that was protecting a religious shrine. The kneeler and window were broken. The suspect also destroyed several flower vases decorating the shrine before fleeing from the area. The damage was well over \$1,000.00.

Surveillance video stills of the suspect were disseminated to patrol officers working in the area. On April 4, 2018 at approximately 5:15 p.m., Central Division patrol officers were flagged down at 1900 National Avenue in Barrio Logan by two females. One of the females closely resembled the vandalism suspect in the video stills and was identified as the suspect. The suspect was identified as 26-year old Kelly Duggan and she was arrested for felony vandalism and booked into jail.
