Search Warrants Served For Illegal Marijuana Delivery Service

San Diego—April 11, 2018, at approximately 0800 hours, the San Diego Police Department's Narcotics Unit served search warrants at 4080 Huerfano Avenue and 2151 Oliver Avenue. Both locations were located within residential apartment complexes. These locations were being used to operate an illegal marijuana delivery service called Pacific Highlife.

The search warrant yielded approximately 7 lbs. of high grade marijuana, 1.5 lbs. of concentrated cannabis, \$3,000 cash, and business documents and records. An employee was arrested for operating a business without a license and sales of marijuana. The investigation is continuing with charges anticipated for other operators of the business who were not present at the time of the search warrants.

Enforcement and Prosecution of all Illegal Marijuana Businesses in San Diego

As was evident by yesterday's operation, SDPD and the City Attorney's office are continuing to conduct enforcement on all illegal marijuana delivery services, as well as, all other illegal marijuana businesses operating in the City of San Diego. All persons operating these illegal marijuana businesses will be arrested and prosecuted.
