**Parties Identified in Old Town Neighborhood Homicide**

San Diego- On November 14, 2018, at 6:23 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communications Center received a call from a resident in the 2300 block of Juan Street. The resident said her elderly neighbor was calling for help, saying he had shot his son. Patrol officers arrived a few minutes later and found a deceased male inside with an apparent gunshot wound. The elderly suspect was detained across the street in a neighbor's residence.

San Diego Police Homicide Investigators were called to the scene and are investigating the incident. Investigators are still trying to determine what prompted the shooting, but the suspect and victim are believed to be a father and son who lived together in the residence. The suspect was transported to the Homicide Office for further investigation.

The victim has been identified as 51 year-old Robert Landis Peck. The suspect has been identified as 92 year-old Richard Landis Peck. Richard Peck was arrested and booked into jail for his son's murder. He is due to be arraigned on November 16, 2018 at 1:30 p.m.
