Rancho Bernardo DUI Collision Arrest

San Diego—On November 12, 2018 at 4:33 a.m., 29 year old Mayra Alejandra Gonzalez (05/10/89) was driving a 2015 Chevy Suburban eastbound in the westbound lanes of 15600 Camino Del Norte when she struck a 2011 Jeep Liberty head-on. The collision caused serious injury to the 57 year old male driver of the Jeep. Gonzalez had her three children in the vehicle with her at the time of the collision. Her 8 year old and 2 year old daughters sustained minor injuries. Gonzalez' 9 month old daughter was unrestrained in the vehicle at the time of the collision and sustained life threatening injuries. Gonzalez was also seriously injured and was transported to the hospital. Gonzalez is suspected of being under the influence of alcohol at the time of the collision.

On November 15, 2018, at 1441 hours, Mayra Gonzalez, while still pending medical treatment, was placed under arrest at Palomar Hospital for felony DUI, driving on the wrong side of the roadway and felony child endangerment.
