

RE: Direct Docketing Request for the Resolution in Support of Attracting the National Medal of Honor Museum to San Diego, California

This memorandum serves as the formal request to direct docket a Council Resolution expressing support for attracting the National Medal of Honor Museum to San Diego, California.

The proposed action would be the approval of the resolution in favor of attracting the national Medal of Honor Museum to San Diego.

The National Medal of Honor Museum Foundation, a 501(c)(3) educational institution, is committed to building a national treasure and making the National Medal of Honor Museum and Education Center a reality. Given San Diego's strong military presence and tourism efforts, San Diego is one of the top locations being considered for the museum.

This item must be expedited as the National Medal of Honor Museum Foundation has an imminent deadline in early April. City Council support of attracting the museum would not only have a positive effect in this process but would demonstrate the City's commitment to its vast population of active servicemembers and veterans alike.
