Subject: Summary of Department Operational Changes

As the COVID-19 pandemic's impact is continuously evolving, the Development Services Department (DSD) is adjusting how it provides essential City services to customers. DSD operational changes are fluid and updated as needed to help ensure the health, safety and well-being of customers and employees of essential businesses.

DSD sends process update [emails to subscribed customers](#) to keep stakeholders informed of the latest news, as significant operational changes are incorporated. An email recap will be sent at the end of the week if significant changes occur. Customers are encouraged to visit sandiego.gov/dsd-covid19 to keep updated on all of the latest changes. Here is a summary of this week's service changes:

- **Election Day Construction Restrictions from Oct. 31 – Nov. 3:** The Presidential General Election takes place on Saturday, Oct. 31, 2020, through Tuesday, Nov. 3, 2020. During this four-day timeframe, within 1 mile of the [nearest polling location](#), all planned construction activities that involve roadway work or impede traffic must be postponed, and all traffic controls reducing lanes or speed must be removed.

Suspension of work includes, but is not limited to, trench and utility work; saw cutting or paving; private utility work or power outages that would impact access to any polling location. [Learn more.](#)
