Healthy Communities Working Group

Thursday, November 19, 2020 | 1:00 – 2:30 PM Working Group Goal: To increase access to healthcare and healthy food in the Promise Zone

Grants Updates & Discussion

- <u>Local Foods Local Places TA</u>: The Promise Zone submitted an application for this technical assistance opportunity. If approved, this would provide a 2-day workshop to create a plan which uses local foods as a means for neighborhood revitalization.
- <u>Farm to School Grant</u>: This grant application closes on January 8, 2021. Barrio Botany is currently receiving this grant for school gardens within the Promise Zone.

Mercato Presentation (Bita Eisenhut, Mercato) (link)

- Mercato provides e-commerce, managed delivery, target promotions, and data analytics for independent stores and grocers. They provide 24/7 support, marketing campaigns, and allow business owners to set their own terms.
- They are currently working with Pfizer to support payments with EBT/WIC.

Food Vision 2030 Update (Tida Infahsaeng, San Diego Food System Alliance) (link)

- The San Diego Food System Alliance has communicated with over 250 organizations and 900 residents to research and understand community perspectives and needs surrounding food systems.
- Through this process, they have created the following goals: cultivate justice, fight climate change, and build resilience.
- Residents have expressed a desire for more locally owned food businesses and restaurants, community gardens, co-cops, farmers' markets, and shared community kitchens.
