Subject: Response to Regional Stay at Home Order – DSD Operations Continue, Online Permitting Services Available and Limited Records Appointments Until Further Notice

Today, California Gov. Gavin Newsom issued a <u>Stay at Home Order</u> based on the regional availability of intensive care unit capacity. As a reminder, all in-person records review appointments to review archived building plans or records are limited. Paper plan resubmittals and payments will remain open on the first floor, while paper plan pick-ups will continue on the third-floor bridge.

Online and Virtual Services

While in-person services are limited for customer and employee safety, most services are available online.

- All permit applications, submittals and construction changes are processed entirely online 24/7. All new applications for permits and approvals and construction changes for previously issued permits and deferred submittals must be processed online by visiting the Development Services Department (DSD) home page: <u>sandiego.gov/DSD</u>. All permits that are processed and issued digitally will be available online for convenient access.
- Book a virtual counter appointment. DSD's virtual counter service allows you to schedule 30- to 45-minute one-on-one online meetings with staff by visiting the "Most Requested Services" section at <u>sandiego.gov/DSD</u> and clicking on the "Schedule an Appointment" button.

• **Request a virtual inspection.** DSD is now offering optional virtual field inspections for 25 common building inspections for customer convenience while addressing COVID-19 risks and abiding by social distancing requirements. <u>Learn more</u>.
