
Dear San Diego Residents,

San Diego Telephone Town Hall: COVID-19

I want to thank all of you for joining us on the San Diego Telephone Townhall on COVID-19 yesterday. Nearly 1000 people called in yesterday.

I want to thank Mayor Kevin Faulconer, Congressmember Scott Peters, Assemblymember Todd Gloria, and County of San Diego Public Health Officer, Dr. Wilma Wooten for helping provide an overview of the actions taken by every level of government to protect and provide relief during this crisis.

The speakers all stressed the need to follow the <u>Stay-At-Home</u> public order so that we can protect the public health and slow the spread of the virus.



My office is working on uploading the audio recording of the call and providing responses to the questions received. When those are available on my website, I will share an update.

City of San Diego updates

Mayor Kevin Faulconer gave the following City of San Diego updates:

- All City-Run <u>parks</u>, <u>beaches</u>, <u>boardwalks</u>, <u>and trails</u> are closed following reports of gatherings over the weekend where people were not keeping six feet apart.
- <u>Parking enforcement</u> has been changed so that San Diegans can focus on staying at home rather than moving their vehicles.
 - All parking (except red, white, and blue zones) will be holiday or Sunday hours.
 - Street sweeping and 72-hour parking rules will not be enforced.
- All of Golden Hall and parts of the Convention Center will be used to provide shelter to our unsheltered residents to create more space to serve people experiencing homelessness and allow for adequate physical distancing within current shelter facilities. Public health nurses will be helping in these new spaces, in addition to their current work at nine other shelters and with the Homeless Outreach Team throughout the City.
- The Mayor and I reiterated that there will be **no water shut-offs** for lack of payment in the City.

On the City website, you can view <u>status of City services</u>, and file <u>Get-It-Done reports</u>. Get-It-Done online services are color-coded green/available, yellow/impacted, and red/unavailable and additional contact phone numbers are provided for certain services. Core services are maintained.
