Yesterday, the Council passed two measures to provide protection and relief for those impacted by the COVID-19 crisis.

- **Moratorium on Residential and Commercial Evictions**

- **Creating a San Diego Small Business Relief Fund (SBRF)**

**Application available tomorrow (Friday, March 27) at 5:00 p.m. on the City's Economic Development Department webpage.**

The goal of the SBRF is to help businesses retain employees and sustain continuity of business operations impacted by COVID-19. Approximately \$6.1 million is available in the SBRF, which is being administered by the City of San Diego Economic Development Department.


Financial assistance, in the form of grants and loans, will range from \$10,000 to \$20,000 and will be allocated to eligible, qualified small businesses based on the availability of funds, program guidelines and the submission of all required information and supporting documentation.

**San Diego Eviction Moratorium – Key Points**

- **Effective now thru May 31**
- **Stops landlords from evicting renters and businesses struggling due to COVID-19**
- **Tenants and landlords encouraged to work out payment plan**
- **Tenants must notify landlords of inability to pay on or before date rent is due**
- **Tenants must provide documentation of COVID-19-related hardship within 7 days**
- **Tenants have 6 months to pay unpaid rent; landlords may not charge late fees**
