Dear San Diego Residents,

Last week, San Diego County issued a <u>new health order</u> requiring all residents to wear a face covering when going out in public beginning on Friday, May 1.

#### Limited Park, Trail, and Beach Reopenings

Last week, Mayor Faulconer opened City of San Diego <u>community and neighborhood parks</u>, as well as certain trails in Open Space parks, for passive purposes only (walking, jogging, or hiking). Park parking lots remain closed and park patrons should only be visiting parks that are within walking distance from their neighborhoods. A list of District Nine parks that are open is <u>on my website</u> along with other COVID-19 resources.

<u>Phase One</u> of the beach reopening process began yesterday. Please maintain social distancing and wear a facial covering when out in public.

**Friday, April 24,** I sent a <u>letter</u> to Governor Newsom asking him to join me in denouncing the response to the COVID-19 outbreak at the Otay Mesa Detention Center and calling for the federal government to take action to protect ill and vulnerable detainees:

**Join us Thursday, April 30**, **at 6:00 p.m.** for a Special Evening Meeting to hear from the public on the upcoming FY2021 City budget that goes into effect on July 1. **We want to hear from you!** Earlier this week, the Mayor pre-

sented his <u>proposed budget</u> to the City Council giving a starting point for this process.

The COVID-19 pandemic has created a budget crisis for the city that will require extremely difficult decisions.

On Friday, April 24, I sent a memo to the Mayor stating that as the City begins its budget process, we must ensure that we are maximizing federal CARES Act funding (\$248 million) to minimize service and staffing cuts.

As the calendar shows, there will be several hearings for you to make your voice heard. In normal times, this would involve the opportunity for
