### **The Zoom Application**

### **Meeting Guidelines**

Meeting participants will initially be admitted into the meeting “waiting room.” The Chair or staff will move participants from there to the meeting itself. When entering the meeting, all participants will be muted. Leave your device muted during the meeting unless acknowledged to speak.
