

## Board of Building Appeals and Advisors Application Period Now Open

The <u>City of San Diego Board of Building Appeals and Advisors</u> is seeking applicants to fill existing vacancies. See below for a description of the Board:

- The Board meets on an as-needed basis and serves to advise the City of San Diego Chief Building Official on the suitability of alternative materials, designs, or construction methods for projects within the City. It also recommends reasonable interpretations of the City's Fire Code; the Building, Electrical, Plumbing, Mechanical, Residential Building, Green Building and existing building regulations of the Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations; and other matters referred by the Chief Building Official. It also may conduct public hearings upon the passage of new legislation on the design and construction of buildings and provide recommendations to the City Council.
- Meetings are scheduled on an as-needed basis, in the afternoon on the first Thursday of the month. They are in-person meetings unless virtual meetings are scheduled.
- The 10-member advisory Board consists of licensed civil, electrical, fire protection, mechanical and structural engineers, licensed architects, and accessibility representatives.
   The Board also includes a member at large and a representative for the construction industry.
- After appointment by the Mayor and confirmation by the City Council, board members
  voluntarily serve a two-year term without compensation. Reappointments are at the
  Mayor's will; however, only a maximum of eight consecutive years in office is and four
  years must pass before such members can be reappointed into office after terming out.
