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SD PromiseZone

- This working group had a goal to increase affordable housing at the beginning of the Promise Zone's designation but have had difficulty engaging with people who could build housing due to infrequent meetings and lack of operational capacity.
 - This working group has chosen to focus on renter assistance and homeless resources for now.
 - San Diego Housing Commission is incorporating updates on affordable housing development in its board meetings. Mapping is done <u>on their</u> <u>website</u>.
- <u>Community Action Plan on Homelessness</u>: Metrics and a housing plan will be on the SDHC website soon. Current progress is viewable on the <u>Community</u> <u>Action Plan Dashboard</u>.
- Promise Zone staff aims to create connections among developers and community based organizations as plans to build more housing units increase.
